I WELCOME PLAZA AND FOUNTAIN

A perfect place to gather, with a backlit granite fountain where water falls over ripples carved in stone.

2 BADGER PRIDE WALL

An 80-foot-long, backlit wall of COR-TEN steel features Madison artist Nate Koehler's whimsical renditions of UW icons.

3 ALUMNI WAY

Along the central walkway, 18-foot-long limestone and porcelain panels represent the pillars of the Wisconsin Idea: Service, Discovery, Tradition, Leadership, and Progress.

4 THE LANTERN

A seven-foot-high steel cone, lit from within illuminates 10 decades of university culture, and inspirational quotations from alumni commencement speakers.
